PIN participants discussed updates to Texas Administrative Code Chapter 228. Most changes apply to educator preparation programs. Participants were directed to review changes applicable to leadership preparation programs on page 15 of the Frequently Asked Questions. These updates focus on new requirements related to informal observations and PIN members discussed strategies for addressing these changes as they relate to Coursework and Clinical Practice.

- ➤ UT-Austin members shared examples of how their program documents their informal observations, including the timeline and the purpose of the observation.
- ➤ Other PIN members discussed opportunities to integrate informal observation documentation into existing observation cycles and systems, such as utilizing existing video recording assignments for observation.
