You can become a leader in the field of public-school athletic administration with Stephen F. Austin State University's Master of Education in educational leadership with athletic director concentration.

Through this 30-hour, completely online program, teachers and coaches can earn an educational leadership master's degree, develop the skills to supervise both coaches and student-athletes, and

meet many of the requirements for eventual principal certification, all while remaining fully employed.

Note: This degree does not provide preparation for a Texas Education Agency certification because there is no State Board of Education certification specifically for athletic directors in Texas. Assignments comply with the Texas core competencies for administrators and meet Educational Leadership Constituent Council standards.

### Admission requirements

- A bachelor's degree from an accredited university
- Minimum overall GPA: 2.5
- Valid teaching certification
- Two years of teaching experience
- GRE not required
